

## **English (Descriptive – 100 Marks)**

**This section checks your writing and communication skills. Key topics include:**

- Essay Writing on general or current issues
- Precis Writing (summary writing)
- Grammar (Tenses, Voice, Narration, Prepositions, etc.)
- Vocabulary (Synonyms, Antonyms, Usage)
- Report & Letter Writing (formal/informal)

## **General Knowledge (Objective – 100 Marks)**

**This paper covers national and Assam-specific general awareness topics. Focus on:**

- Indian History & Culture (especially Assam)
- Geography of India & Assam
- Indian Constitution & Polity
- Economy of India & Assam
- Current Affairs (national & international)
- Environment & Ecology
- General Science
- Mental Ability & Reasoning (basic level)

## **Optional Subjects (Objective – 200 Marks each)**

**Candidates must choose any two optional subjects. Each will have a separate paper of 200 marks. The syllabus is of Bachelor's degree level. Subjects include:**

- Agriculture
- Botany
- Chemistry
- Computer Applications / Computer Science
- Environmental Science
- Forestry
- Geology
- Horticulture
- Mathematics
- Physics
- Statistics
- Veterinary Science
- Zoology
- Engineering (Agricultural, Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, Chemical)
